Pastor's Paragraphs

Weekend of February 18 & 19, 2012

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, the liturgical season in which we accompany Christ in his Passion for 46 days until Easter. It reminds us also of the 40 days Jesus spent in the desert fasting and praying, preparing for his ministry. That's why we begin Lent with fasting and praying and we give something up, just as Christ gave his life up for you and me, for our salvation. We should also use this time to prepare for our own ministry, God's plan for holiness for us, and also for an increase of God's presence in our lives, giving up sin, even after Lent is over with.

Lent doesn't really end then after Easter. We still have to work for our salvation and the salvation of others. That's why Mother Church asks us to continue, voluntarily, fasting or abstain from meat or something we like on every Friday of the year as a sign of penance and as a gift to God from us by offering him something we like for the salvation of souls. Would you work with me and Msgr. Dan in saving souls in Watertown? Invite someone to church this Lent that you know hasn't been to church lately.

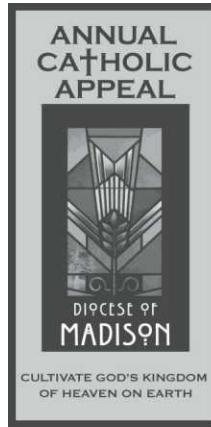
May you have a blessed and fruitful Lent. See you in church!

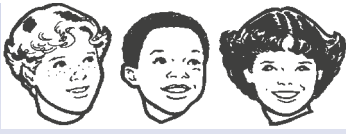
Deepen Your Faith with the Catholic Herald—Feb. 16 issue
